## **Courses and Language Requirements**

- The tuition fees will be waived for all exchange students.
- Each class is 90 minutes.
- Students must take at least 7 classes per week.
- Exchange students may take classes in Japanese, English, or both if they meet the language requirements below.

Course type	Language Requirement	Credits
Taught in Japanese	Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) N2 or above	2 – 4 (depends on the course)
Taught in English	English proficiency of TOEFL iBT 71, IELTS 5.5, CEFR B2, or equivalent	2 – 4 (depends on the course)
Japanese Language Classes	N/A*1	1 – 2*² (depends on the course)

<sup>\*1</sup> Japanese language classes are categorized into seven proficiency levels: ES to E5 as below. For details, please refer to the <u>next page</u> ("Japanese Language Levels").

\*2 Japanese language classes can be registered up to 8 credits per semester.
